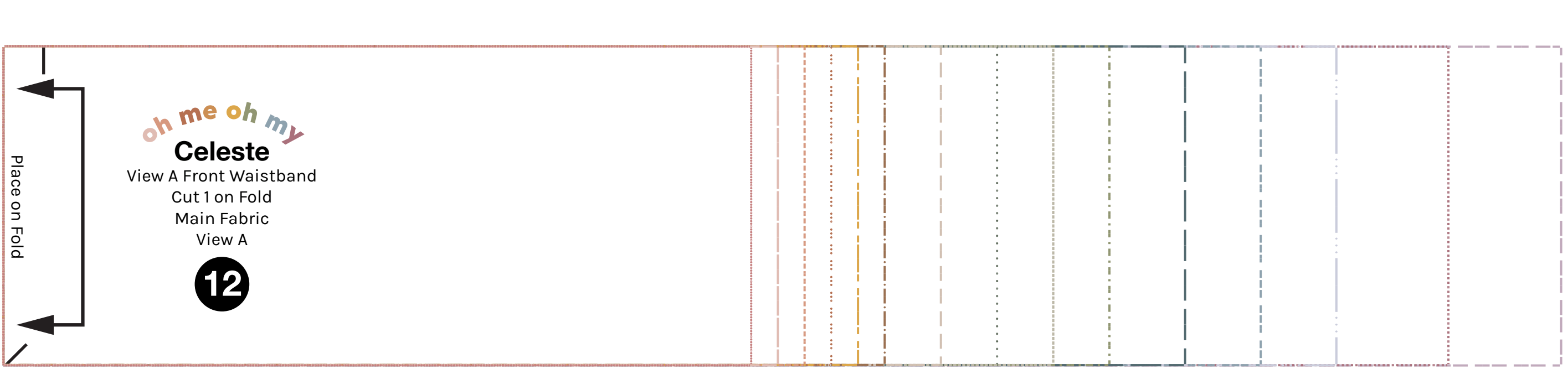
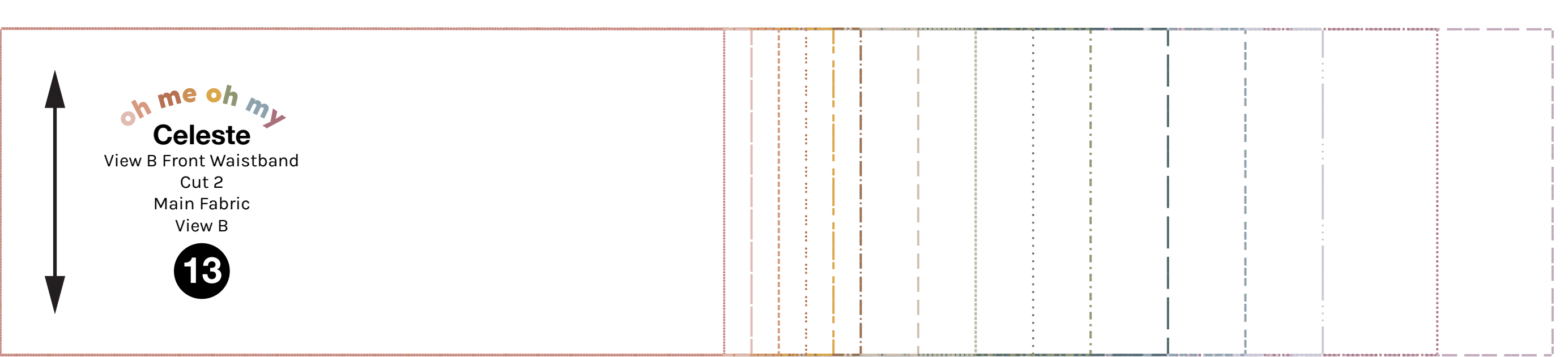
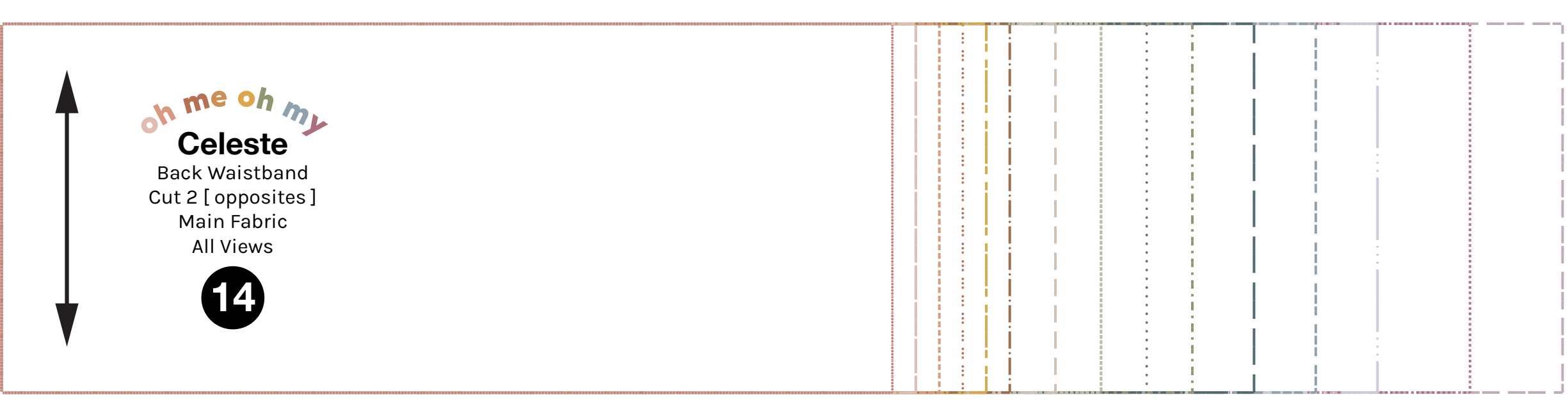
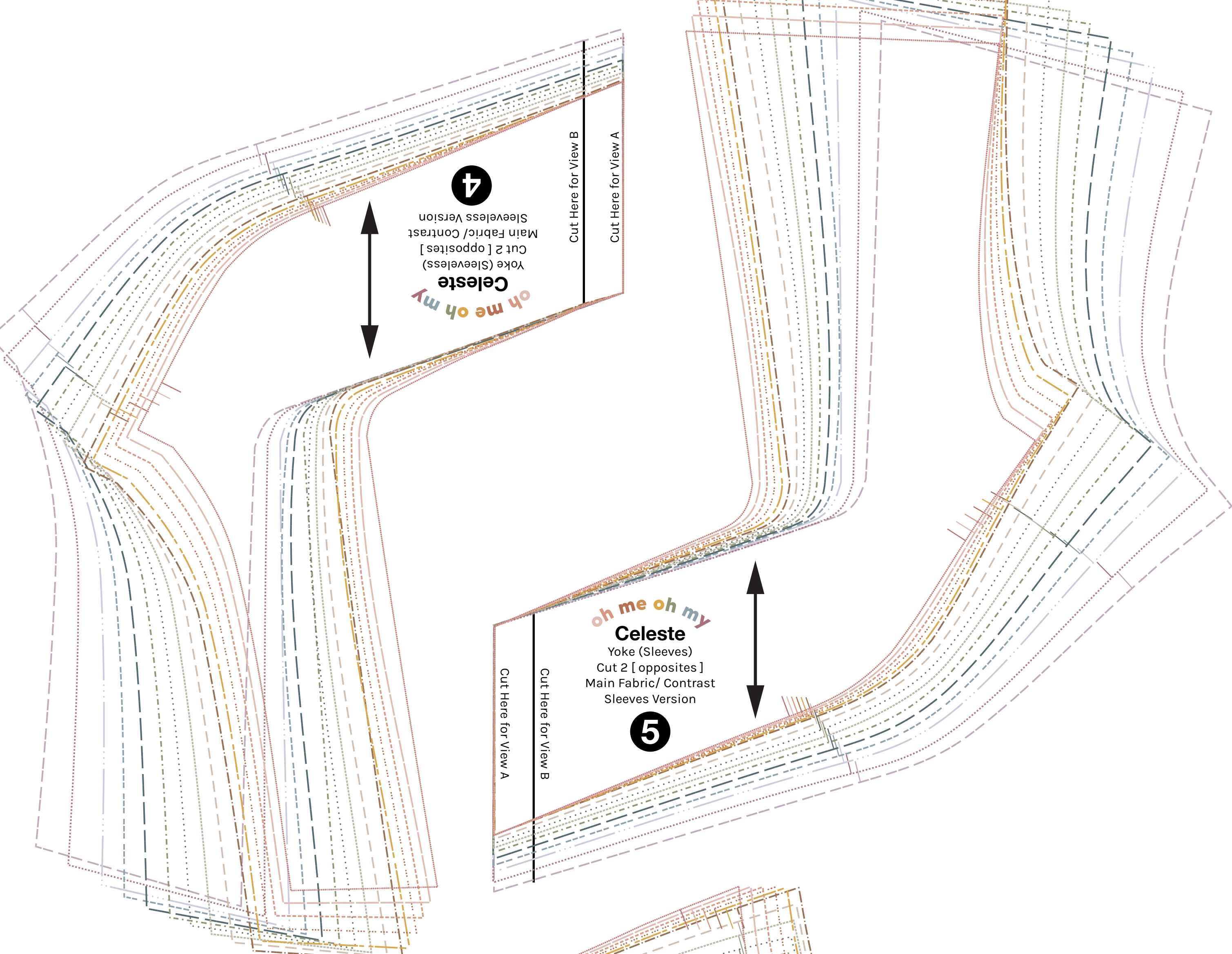
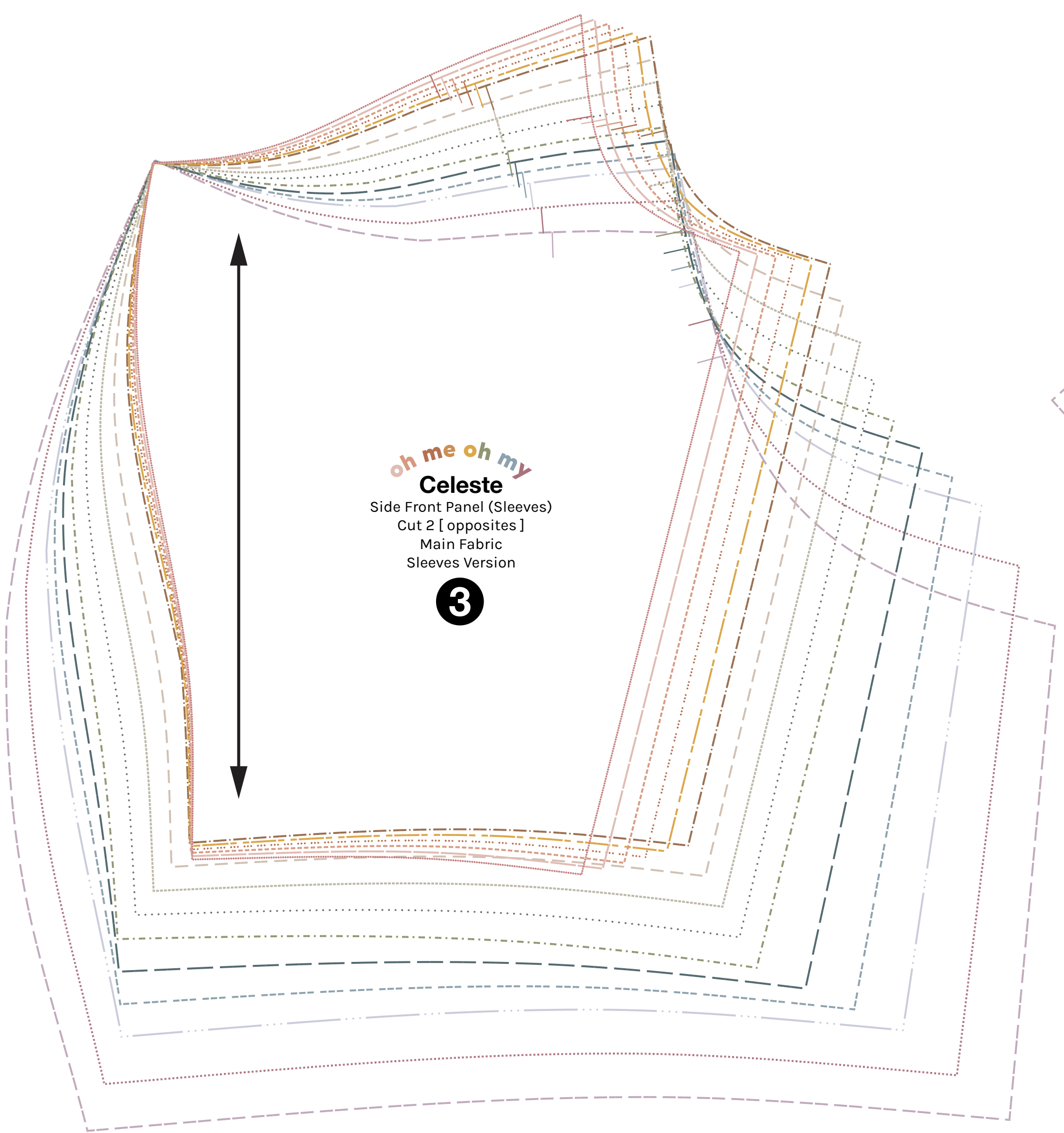
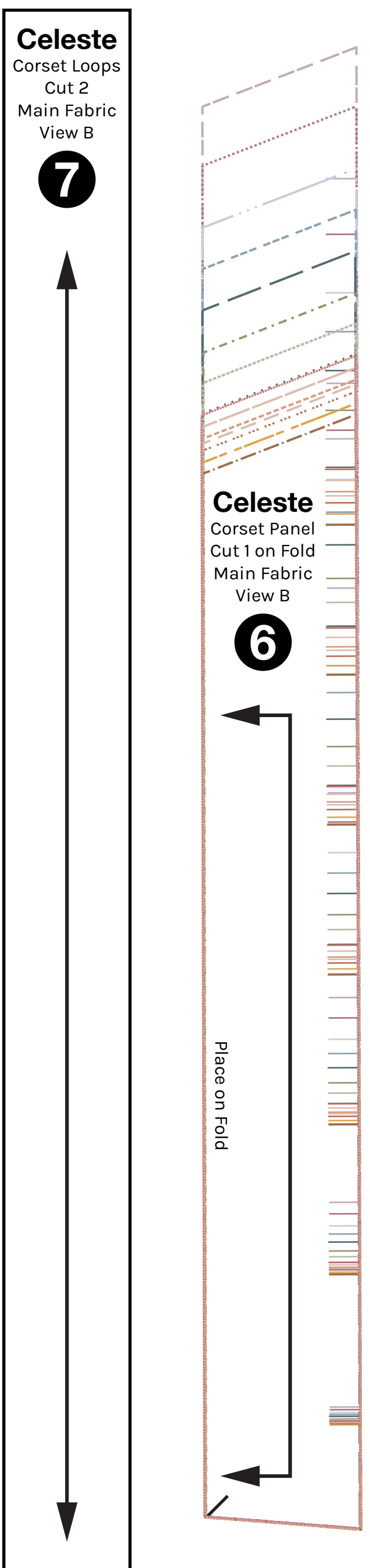
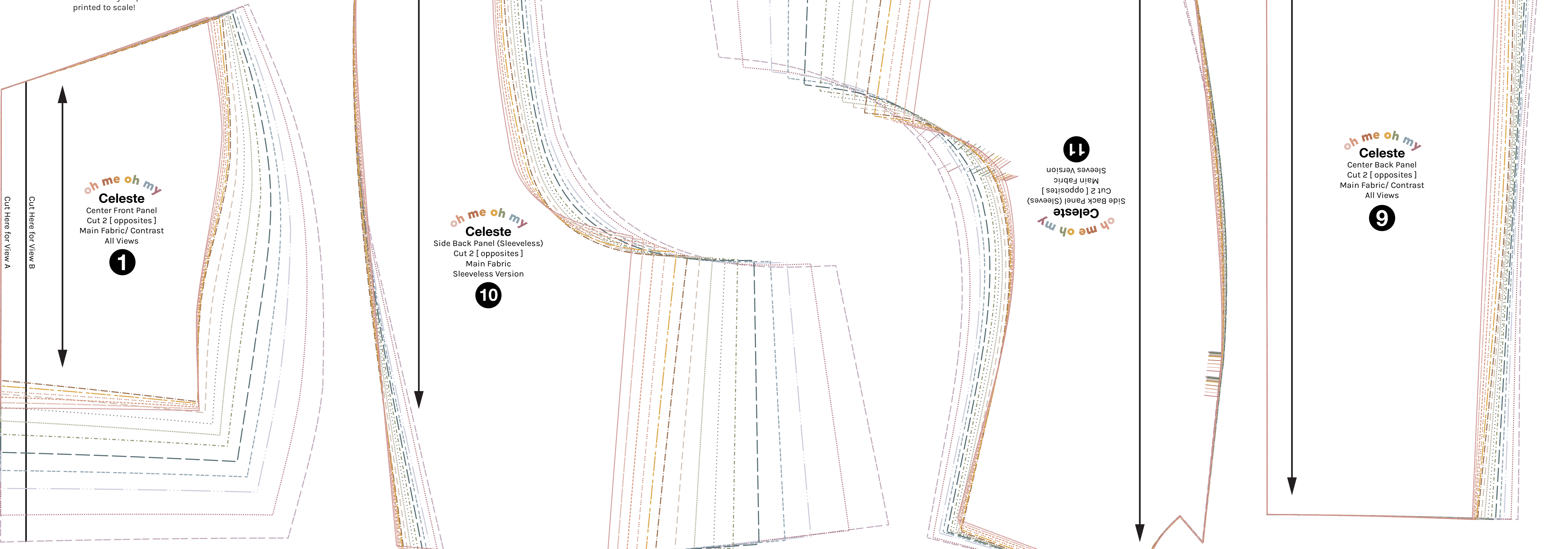
If you'd like to print your pattern out at home, use the "Print at Home" file.
